TITLE:	Motion Approving a Construction Agreement for a New Surface Parking Lot and the Site Improvements Associated with the Relocation of Temporary Fire Station No.13 – Waypoint Contracting Inc \$1,237,903 - (Commission District 2)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve a construction agreement, in substantially the form attached, for the development of a new surface parking lot and the site improvements associated with the relocation to Waypoint Contracting Inc, in the amount of \$1,237,903.

Background

This project is located at 3109 Vistamar Steet in the City of Fort Lauderdale. The City will be developing the parcel into a surface parking lot with 81 public parking spaces. Additionally, a portion of the parcel will be developed to accommodate temporary Fire Station No.13 which consists of a trailer, bunker shed, canvas vehicle bay, an emergency generator, as well as a restricted parking area with 11 parking spaces. The scope of work to be accomplished under proposed agreement includes, but not limited to, clearing and grubbing, demolition or relocation of the utilities, grading, sodding, landscaping, site demolition, storm retention, fire protection, domestic water piping and connections, light/heavy duty asphalt, asphalt overbuild, concrete ADA ramp walks, and lighting. The agreement includes the relocation, recertification, and improvements of an existing trailer currently being utilized near Fire Station No. 54. Staff recommends awarding all Bid Alternates including construction of new shed for the exercise equipment (Bid Alternate 1) and installation of new 30' wide automatic rolling gate (Bid Alternate 2).

On November 17, 2020, the City Commission adopted the Ordinance No. C-20-42 approving a public purpose use for the Temporary Fire Station No. 13 and a surface parking lot (Exhibit 1).

On May 13, 2021, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid No. 12523-113 Temporary Fire Station No. 13 and Parking Area. On July 15, 2021, the City opened six bids received in response to the solicitation. The bids were reviewed for compliance with the solicitation specifications. After review, Waypoint Contracting Inc. was deemed the lowest cost, responsive, and responsible bidder. Three of the six vendors that responded have claimed status as a Minority Business Enterprise, Women Business Enterprise, or Small Business Enterprise.

Resource Impact

There will be a current fiscal year impact to the City in the amount of \$1,237,903 for the contract award including allowances plus bid alternates, and \$173,306 for estimated inhouse project management fees for a total project cost of \$1,411,209. Funds for this agreement in the amount of \$1,019,583 are available in the FY 2021 Community Investment Plan in the accounts listed below. The remaining balance of \$391,626 is contingent upon the approval and appropriation of the consolidated budget amendment CAM #21-0098 at the September 9, 2021, City Commission meeting.
