Storage Property, LLC - (Commission District 3)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a Landscape Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement with Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for improvements within the right-of-way for State Road 842 (Broward Boulevard) between Mile Post 4.844 to Mile Post 4.884 and an Assumption of Liability and Hold Harmless Agreement, in substantially the form attached, with Riverbend Storage Property, LLC.

Background

The City of Fort Lauderdale (City) will enter into a Landscape Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement (MMOA) with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for the purpose of the City maintaining the landscape improvements within the right-of-way on State Road 842 (Broward Boulevard). The MMOA includes provisions allowing the property owner, Riverbend Storage Property, LLC, to construct additional landscape improvements or to modify an improvement on State Road 842 (Broward Boulevard) from Mile Post 4.844 to Mile Post 4.884, and in accordance with the plans attached as Exhibits "A" and "B" to the agreement. The Assumption of Liability and Hold Harmless Agreement (Agreement) between the City and Riverbend Storage Property, LLC, passes the costs associated with the MMOA to Riverbend Storage Property, LLC. Riverbend Storage Property, LLC agrees to assume the City's obligation to maintain the improvements installed by them, in the right of way in accordance with the agreement.
