TITLE: Resolution Supporting Broward County Traffic Engineering Division to post

"NO THRU TRUCKS" Signage on the Northbound Lane of Bayview Drive

at NE 51st Street - (Commission District 1)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution supporting the Broward County Traffic Engineering Division (BCTED) to post a "NO THRU TRUCKS" sign on the northbound lane of Bayview Drive at NE 51st Street.

Background

The Landings Residential Association has shared concerns of increased commercial truck traffic within their residential neighborhood. City Traffic Engineering staff conducted field research in response to the neighborhood's concerns and discovered that commercial truck traffic is traveling northbound on Bayview Drive from East Commercial Boulevard.

The Traffic Engineering Agreement between the City of Fort Lauderdale and Broward County requires the City Commission to approve a Resolution of Support for the installation of "NO THRU TRUCKS" signage. The City of Fort Lauderdale Traffic Engineering staff recommends "NO THRU TRUCKS" signage to be installed on Bayview Drive northbound at the intersection of NE 51st Street to enhance public safety in that residential area.

The installation of proposed sign is recommended, based upon community feedback and with the objective to enhance the safety of the residential street. Proposed signage is expected to improve conditions by alerting commercial truck drivers of the restricted movement, prior to turning onto or continuing north across the bridge into the community on Bayview Drive.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.
