TITLE: Discussion on Future Development of the One Stop Shop - (**Commission
District 2**)

On June 19, 2020, the City received an unsolicited proposal from One Stop Shop, LLC ("Proposer") pursuant to Florida Statutes Section 255.065, to construct a recreational and cultural facility. At the October 6, 2020, City Commission Meeting, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 20-190 determining that the unsolicited proposal submitted by the Proposer serves a public purpose as a recreational and cultural, and as proposed it constituted a Qualifying Project pursuant to Florida Statutes Section 255.065.

At the September 9, 2021, City Commission Meeting, the Commission requested an overview of the proposal to date and an overview of negotiations of the Comprehensive Agreement. The purpose of this Conference item is for the City Commission to provide further direction on the future development of the One Stop Shop site.
