Center Garage and the Transportation & Mobility Building – Maverick United

Elevator LLC - \$285,400 - (Commission Districts 2 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve an agreement, in substantially the form attached, for the purchase of Elevator Repair Services for River Walk Center Garage located at 150 SE 2nd Street, and the Transportation & Mobility Building located at 290 NE 3rd Avenue, from Maverick United Elevator LLC (Maverick), in the estimated amount of \$285,400.

Background

The proposed agreement will provide parts, components, equipment, labor, management, and supervision for the repairs to the City's four (4) Otis Elevators located at the River Walk Center Garage (RWC), and one (1) Miami Elevator located at the Transportation and Mobility Department (TAM) building.

The Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid No. 12566-813 and received three (3) bids. None of the three bidders indicated its status as a Minority Business Enterprise, Women Business Enterprise or Small Business Enterprise. The bid submitted by Maverick has met all the specifications of the bid and has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder.

Resource Impact

Funds for this agreement in the amount of \$285,400 are available in the FY 2021 Budget in the account listed below. Future years' expenditures are contingent upon the approval and appropriation of the annual budgets.
