

RESOLUTION NO. 21-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA DELEGATING TO THE CITY MANAGER THE AUTHORITY TO EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FOR A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$449,718.00 FOR THE HENDRICKS ISLE SEAWALL PROJECT AND TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS NECESSARY OR INCIDENTAL TO ACCEPTANCE OF THE FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the Hendricks Isle Seawall Project is for the replacement of two City-owned seawalls located along Hendricks Isle, measuring 265 linear feet (LF) and 60 linear feet (LF) respectively; and

WHEREAS, these seawalls are over 50 years old and are structurally deficient and functionally obsolete. In addition to their poor structural condition, the existing seawalls are overtopped during higher-than-normal tidal events, negatively impacting infrastructure on the public right-of-way, as well as private property along Hendricks Isle; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection ("FDEP") grant is in the amount of \$449,718.00. Under the terms of the Grant all work must be completed by June 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, will match \$449,718.00, for this Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is delegated the authority to execute the Grant Agreement with FDEP for a \$ 449,718.00 grant for the Hendricks Isle Seawall Project and to execute any and all documents necessary or incidental thereto.

SECTION 2. That the office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by City officials.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon and after its passage.
