Grant Participation Agreement with Winterfest Inc. - \$25,000 -

(Commission District 2)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve the FY 2022 BID Grant Participation Agreement with Winterfest Inc. in the total amount of \$25,000.

Background

At the August 9, 2021 BID Advisory Committee regular meeting, Winterfest Inc. requested BID sponsorship in the amount of \$25,000 to support the Winterfest Parade Viewing and Festival portion of the larger Winterfest Boat Parade event scheduled for December 11, 2021. The BID Advisory Committee unanimously approved the funding request in a (8-0) vote (Exhibit 1).

The Winterfest Parade Viewing and Festival event will be located at the Las Olas Intracoastal Promenade Park where a variety of illuminated boats will be coasting through the waterway. The proposed activities for the site will include, but are not limited to, live music, food and beverages for purchase, sponsor activations, sampling, vendor booths, interactive games, and a viewing area. The BID Grant Application provides further details of the event (Exhibit 2).

The estimated cost to produce this event is \$150,000. The applicant is seeking additional sponsorship to cover expenses for the event and has secured commitments from Lacroix, Stella Artois, and Florida Panthers. Funds from the BID will only be used to support overall costs associated with producing the event. The allowable expenditures include: fencing, security, restrooms, sanitation, cleanup, promotions, brochures, marketing, logistics, City support services such as police detail, fire and emergency services, television, newspaper, magazines, social media, entertainment, power, lighting, tents, tables as well as barricades and traffic signage.

The Beach Business Improvement Assessment is a non-ad valorem assessment for the cost of providing beach business improvement services, facilities and programs that have

10/05/2021 CAM #21-0587 a special benefit to business property located within the beach area. This proposal is consistent with the legislative determinations of special benefit found in C-06-34, Section 1.04(A)(2), Fort Lauderdale Code of Ordinances, by increasing the number of visitors to the BID.

Reimbursement of the funds will be contingent on approval of a Grant Participation Agreement with the City (Exhibit 3).
