- TITLE: Resolution (a) Approving an Application for a Dock Permit for Usage of Public Property by William & Ethel McIntyre / 1516 Ponce De Leon Drive – and (b) Authorizing Execution of a Declaration of Covenants -(Commission District 4)

### **Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution (a) granting a dock permit for use by private persons of public property for William & Ethel McIntyre at 1516 Ponce De Leon Drive, Fort Lauderdale, FL and (b) authorizing execution by the proper City officials of a Declaration of Covenants.

#### **Background**

The applicants are seeking a resolution granting a dock permit for use by private persons of public property in accordance with Section 8-144 of the Code of Ordinances for the installation, use, maintenance and repair of a proposed concrete marginal dock, floating dock, and associated ramp adjacent to 1516 Ponce De Leon Drive.

In conjunction therewith City Code Sec. 8-144 requires execution of a Declaration of Covenants Respecting a City Issued Dock Permit ("Declaration"). Applicants are also seeking a resolution authorizing counter-execution by the proper City officials of the Declaration.

Per Resolution 19-205, an application fee of \$1500. is associated with obtaining a dock permit.

The Marine Advisory Board recommended unanimous approval (12-0) of the application (see Exhibit 3).

#### Resource Impact

There is a positive fiscal impact in the amount of \$1,500. Revenue related to the application fee is included in the FY2022 Operating Budget in the account listed below.
