- **TITLE**: Resolution Supporting Broward County Traffic Engineering Division to Post "NO THRU TRUCKS" Signage on the Eastbound Lane of SW 27th Court at SW 15th Avenue - **(Commission District 4)**

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a Resolution supporting the Broward County Traffic Engineering Division (BCTED) to post a "NO THRU TRUCKS" sign on the eastbound lane of SW 27th Court at SW 15th Avenue.

Background

Transportation and Mobility staff received a neighbor request to replace a missing "NO THRU TRUCKS" sign at the intersection of SW 27th Court and SW 15th Avenue. Upon a field visit by Broward County Traffic Engineering Division staff, the sign was confirmed missing.

The Traffic Engineering Agreement between the City of Fort Lauderdale and Broward County requires the City Commission to approve a Resolution of Support for the installation of "NO THRU TRUCKS" signage. BCTED had no record of a previous resolution approving the sign at the described location and is requesting a Resolution be passed to install the signage. Transportation and Mobility staff recommends a "NO THRU TRUCKS" sign be installed at eastbound SW 27th Court from SW 15th Avenue for the purposes of enhancing public safety in that residential area by alerting commercial truck drivers of the restricted movement within the area.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.
