TITLE: Resolution Approving Fiscal Year 2022 Not for Profit Grant Participation

Agreement with Areawide Council on Aging of Broward County, Inc. -

\$127,842 - (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution approving a City of Fort Lauderdale FY 2022 Not for Profit Grant Participation Agreement with Areawide Council on Aging of Broward County,Inc., a not-for-profit corporation, in the amount of \$127,842, and authorizing execution of the agreement.

Background

With the adoption of the FY 2022 Budget, the City Commission approved contributions to not-for-profit organizations that support the needs of the community while making a positive impact. The participation agreement provides for the maximum funding amount, terms of contribution, scope of services, and standards of performance.

Areawide Council on Aging of Broward County,Inc., plans, develops, coordinates, and evaluates programs, funds services, and is the prime advocate for Broward County residents 60 years of age or older. The funding will be used to match federal and state grants to provide approximately 50,000 home-delivered meals to an estimated 125 homebound year-round residents of the City of Fort Lauderdale who are 60 years of age or older ("Clients"), and approximately 25,000 congregate meals to about 150 Clients at 32 meal sites around Broward County.

Resource Impact

There is a fiscal impact to the General Fund in the amount of \$127,842 in FY 2022. Funding is budgeted and available in the account on the following page.
