

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. C-84-88 IN ORDER TO FACILITATE THE RENAMING OF S.W. 1ST AVENUE AND N.W. 1ST AVENUE FROM WEST LAS OLAS BOULEVARD TO SISTRUNK BOULEVARD IN THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, TO "MARY BRICKELL AVENUE," AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCE PROVISIONS, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on October 16, 1984, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, passed Ordinance No. C-84-88, which amended the street name of that portion of S.W. 1st Avenue from North New River Drive West to Broward Boulevard, to also be known as "Brickell Avenue"; and

WHEREAS, the portion of Brickell Avenue between West Las Olas Boulevard and North New River Drive West was vacated as part of the Riverwalk Redevelopment; and

WHEREAS, during the City Commission Conference meeting of May 5, 2026, the City Commission discussed renaming that portion of S.W. 1st Avenue from West Las Olas Boulevard to Broward Boulevard, known as "Brickell Avenue," to "Mary Brickell Avenue"; and

WHEREAS, during the City Commission Conference meeting of May 5, 2026, the City Commission acknowledged that the portion of N.W. 1st Avenue from Broward Boulevard to Sistrunk Boulevard is known as "Mary Brickell Avenue" as a secondary street name; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires consistency and wishes to rename S.W. 1st Avenue and N.W. 1st Avenue from West Las Olas Boulevard to Sistrunk Boulevard to the primary street name of "Mary Brickell Avenue"; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. C-84-88 must be repealed in order to facilitate the renaming of S.W. 1st Avenue and N.W. 1st Avenue from North New River Drive West to Sistrunk Boulevard to "Mary Brickell Avenue"; and

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WHEREAS, Ordinance No. C-84-88 was not codified in the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. C-84-88 of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. That if any clause, section or other part of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall not take effect unless and until the adoption of a resolution that facilitates the renaming of that portion of Southwest 1st Avenue between West Las Olas Boulevard and Broward Boulevard.
