TITLE: Resolution Calling Special Election; Charter Amendments - (**Commission
Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4**)

Recommendation

The City Attorney recommends that the City Commission adopt a resolution calling a special election for November 3, 2026, and establishing a procedure for placing ballot measures on the November 3, 2026, special election ballot that, if passed, would amend the Charter of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

Background

The proposed resolution would authorize the Broward County Supervisor of Elections to place ten ballot measures on a November 3, 2026, special election ballot. If approved by a majority of the electors of the City of Fort Lauderdale voting in the special election, the measures would amend and create various provisions of the Charter of the City of Fort Lauderdale.
