

RESOLUTION NO. 26-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE SIDEWALK MASTER PLAN IN THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, RECISSION OF CONFLICTING RESOLUTION PROVISIONS AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in Fiscal Year 2023, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale ("City") approved funding to develop a citywide Sidewalk Master Plan to identify and prioritize sidewalk gaps using a data-driven and a community-informed approach; and

WHEREAS, on January 22, 2025, the Transportation and Mobility staff presented the prioritization framework and preliminary results to the City Commission, and the City Commission recommended an initial focus on the implementation of one side of the street to maximize geographic coverage and delivery efficiency; and

WHEREAS, city staff finalized the prioritization and conducted desktop feasibility reviews to identify segments suitable for initial implementation; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Phase I implementation consists of approximately thirty-eight (38) miles of new sidewalks across all four City of Fort Lauderdale Commission Districts including:

- District 1 – 7.8 miles
- District 2 – 10.7 miles
- District 3 – 9.9 miles
- District 4 – 9.9 miles; and

WHEREAS, a list of the recommended neighborhoods for each district is set forth in the Commission District Table, of the City of Fort Lauderdale City Commission Agenda Memo #26-0164, attached and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that it is in the best interest of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, to accept the Sidewalk Master Plan as presented in the City of Fort Lauderdale City Commission Agenda Memo #26-0164;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA THAT:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. The City hereby accepts the Sidewalk Master Plan, as shown in the City of Fort Lauderdale City Commission Agenda Memo #26-0164, attached and incorporated herein.

SECTION 3. If any clause, section or other part of this Resolution shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall not be affected thereby but shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final adoption.
