Each Commission Member disclosed verbal communications, written communications, site visits, and expert opinions received.

Mayor Trantalis opened the public hearing.

Mayor Trantalis recognized Steve Witten, 33 S. Gordon Road, Marine Advisory Board (MAB) Chair. Chair Witten explained details of the MABs input regarding this Agenda item. Further comment and discussion ensued.

In response to Mayor Trantalis' question, Chair Witten said that the MAB's recommendation to deny the dock waiver application was not related to technical or navigational issues, but because of concerns about the applicant's past conduct. Further comment and discussion ensued.

Commissioner Glassman commented that the MAB's denial is rooted in enforcement concerns and said that Code should enforce rules uniformly versus rejecting an otherwise compliant dock waiver application and expounded on his viewpoint. Commissioner Glassman said that the area's Civic Association President did not object to this dock waiver request. Further comment and discussion ensued.

Mayor Trantalis discussed his perspective regarding support of this dock waiver request and the need for Code enforcement in this area of the waterway. Further comment and discussion ensued.

In response to Commissioner Beasley-Pittman's concerns regarding oversight and enforcement, Mayor Trantalis clarified that past concerns were a number of years ago and involved a different vessel, which should not be the basis for denying the current dock waiver request. Further comment and discussion ensued.
