A1A/Seabreeze Boulevard and Castillo Street Rectangular Rapid Flashing  
Beacons - **(Commission District 2)**

**Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution approving and authorizing execution of the Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement (MMOA) with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for the State Road A1A/Seabreeze Boulevard and Castillo Street Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB), in substantially the form attached.

**Background**

In January 2024, the City of Fort Lauderdale received concerns related to pedestrian safety at the crosswalk on State Road A1A/Seabreeze Boulevard at Castillo Street. FDOT evaluated and determined that the crosswalk warranted installation of RRFBs to improve operational safety at the pedestrian crossing. The project design includes the installation of two (2) RRFBs with associated signage and pavement markings at the north crosswalk of the intersection. Funding for implementation is programmed for this fiscal year.

FDOT requires that municipalities maintain any non-standard features on state right-of-way, including RRFBs, as these elements are beyond the FDOT standard treatment. The MMOA formalizes the City's maintenance obligations, identifying the location and maintenance requirements of the improvements to be maintained by the City within FDOT right-of-way. Once the MMOA is executed, FDOT will issue the work order, and construction is expected to take place in fall 2026.

**Resource Impact**

There is no fiscal impact to the City associated with this action in the current fiscal year. Annual funding for future maintenance and repairs (as needed) in the amount of \$6,500 is available as part of the Parks and Recreation Department operating budget.
