Upcoming Florida State Senate Bill 382, and the October 1, 2026, Micromobility Safety Task Force report will help inform subsequent phases of local regulation. TAM has been conducting briefings with elected officials. Districts 1 and 4 briefings were conducted, and briefings are currently scheduled with the Mayor's Office as well as Districts 2 and 3. Next steps include incorporating any changes based on feedback from the elected officials, a public town hall meeting, and introduction of the ordinance for the first reading, which is anticipated in June 2026, unless feedback from the elected officials prompt additional changes. 5	Naming of Brickell	Mayor Trantalis and Commissioner Glassman requested the City to complete the naming of NW 1st Avenue and Sistrunk Boulevard with pioneer Mary Brickell's name. A related Commission Item may have been passed in the early 2000's.	04/13/2026 - A Letter to Commission (LTC) has been drafted and under review. The LTC outlining that although the City Commission approved a 2004 Resolution to designate NW 1 Avenue between Broward Boulevard and Sistrunk Boulevard as "Mary Brickell Avenue", the change was never implemented because the Resolution was not transmitted to Broward County. To ensure consistency with the signed section south of Broward Boulevard, City staff will prepare a new resolution proposing "Brickell Avenue" as the secondary street name for the corridor.
