TITLE: Motion Approving an Agreement for Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. 595-1 for FXE Taxiway Bravo & Quebec Realignment Project - Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc. - \$3,934,061.15 - **(Commission District 1)**

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve an agreement, in substantially the form attached, for Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. 595-1 for the FXE Taxiway Bravo & Quebec Realignment Project with Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc., in the total amount of \$3,934,061.15, which includes an allowance of \$45,000 for modifications to the existing Airfield Lighting Control and Monitoring System (ALCMS) and airfield sign panels.

Background

The project aims to improve airport safety by realigning existing Taxiways Bravo and Quebec at the Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport (FXE). Currently, aircraft holding short of Runway 9-27 on Taxiways Foxtrot and Bravo are located within the Runway 13 Runway Protection Zone (RPZ). The realignment of Taxiways Bravo and Quebec will allow aircraft to remain clear of the RPZ. In addition, Taxiway Quebec will be reconstructed perpendicular to Runway 9-27, as recommended by the latest Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) airport design standards.

The scope of work consists of improvements to Taxiways Bravo and Quebec, including, but is not limited to, mobilization, site preparation, maintenance of traffic, pavement removal and reconstruction, asphalt paving, milling and overlay operations, installation of airfield signage and edge lighting systems, and the application of pavement markings in accordance with FAA standards. FDOT awarded the City a \$1,633,600 Public Transportation Grant Agreement (PTGA) to support this project (CAM # 23-0074).

On April 13, 2026, the City, via the Procurement Services Department, issued Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. 595 - FXE Taxiway Bravo & Quebec Realignment Project. The ITB opened on May 18, 2026. One (1) addendum was issued to revise bid line item 15, plan set sheets, and technical specifications. Three (3) bids were received in response to the solicitation from the following firms:

- 1) General Asphalt Co., LLC
- 2) Ranger Construction Industries, Inc.
- 3) Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc.

All bids were reviewed for compliance with the solicitation requirements. Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc., met all ITB requirements and was deemed the low, responsive and responsible bidder.

Staff recommends award to Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc.

Resource Impact

There is a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$3,934,061.15, inclusive of an allowance in the amount of \$45,000 for modifications to the existing Airfield Lighting Control and Monitoring System (ALCMS) and airfield sign panels. Funds for this agreement, in the amount of \$3,934,061.15 that includes \$1,633,600 in FDOT grant funds, are available in the Fiscal Year (FY) 2026 Community Investment Plan in the accounts listed below:
