Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve a motion designating the City's representative to the Florida League of Cities' Nominating Committee to the ten most populous cities seat on the League's Board of Directors for 2026-2027.

Background

The Nominating Committee will meet August 13-15, 2026, at the Diplomat Beach Resort in Hollywood, Florida in conjunction with the Florida League of Cities Annual Conference. The City of Fort Lauderdale has a seat on the League's Board of Directors as one of Florida's ten most populous cities. Board seats are for a one-year term. Last year, the City Commission designated Mayor Dean J. Trantalis.
