IMPLEMENTATION ENGINEERING CONSULTING SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS RETROACTIVE STORMWATER MASTER PLAN MODELING AND DESIGN IMPLEMENTATION ENGINEERING CONSULTING SERVICES AGREEMENT (“Agreement”) made and entered into this _____ day of _____ 2026, by and between the City of Fort Lauderdale, a Florida municipal corporation (“City”) and Hazen and Sawyer, P.C., a Florida corporation (“Consultant”) (“Party” or collectively “Parties”)

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, at its meeting of April 16, 2016, authorized the proper City officials, by motion, to execute a Consultant Services Agreement with the Consultant in an amount of \$7,578,756 (CAM #16-0408); and

WHEREAS, while the City Commission approved the Agreement, it removed the authorization for administrative approval of the two (2), five-year options, and instead mandated City Commission approval for the two (2) options; and

WHEREAS, the first five (5)-year renewal option was effective April 19, 2021, and was approved and affirmed by City Commission November 16, 2021; and

WHEREAS, although the second five (5)-year renewal option was signed on April 17, 2026, by the City and the Consultant prior to expiration of April 18, 2026, it was not approved by the City Commission and thus the Agreement expired; and

WHEREAS, the City and Consultant are desirous of renewing the agreement for the final five (5)-year period.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties hereto, in consideration of the mutual covenants, agreements, terms, and conditions contained herein, do agree to the following:

1.1 The recitations set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated herein. Initial capitalized terms or other such terms used herein shall have the same meaning given such terms in the Original Agreement, unless otherwise defined herein or unless the context otherwise indicates.

1.2 The Original Agreement and all terms and conditions of the Original Agreement are incorporated into and made part of this Agreement.

1.3 This Agreement will be retroactive to April 18, 2026. This is the last extension to the Agreement which will expire on April 17, 2031.

1.4 A consumer price index (CPI) increase of two point five seven percent (2.57%) is hereby approved for the final option period.
