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Updates since May 19 Presentation

June 15, 2026:

The Executive Committee and Governing Board unanimously recommended two (2) opt-out opportunities incorporated into a Second Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement (ILA):

- An opt-out after the Request For Proposal (RFP) process was concluded for any reason on or before December 31, 2027; and
- An opt-out in August 2048.

The Second Amendment MUST be approved by 100% of the Participating Municipalities to be in effect

Updates since May 19 Presentation

June 15, 2026:

The discussions at the Executive Committee meeting regarding the request for a seat on the Executive Committee:

- There is a seat available for the Large Cities that would be coming up for election
- Decision was to hold election for the seat at September 2026 meeting of the Governing Board

Updates since May 19 Presentation

- Seventeen (17) municipalities and Broward County have approved the Facilities Amendment as of June 24, 2026, representing over forty-five percent (**45.55%**) of the population of Broward County
- The ILA requires it must be approved by municipalities representing eighty percent (**80%**) of the population of Broward County and by Broward County:
 - If meets the threshold - it is the formation condition for the Broward Solid Waste Authority
 - If it fails to meet the threshold - the Broward Solid Waste Authority will cease to exist

Updates since May 19 Presentation

- There are eleven (11) remaining participating municipalities that still need to vote on Facilities Amendment as of June 24, 2026.
- The corresponding population percentages for each of these municipalities and its projected Facilities Amendment decision date are provided in the table.
