

RESOLUTION NO. 26-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, ADOPTING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH BROWARD COUNTY FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION AND PARTICIPATION IN THE BROWARD RAPID ALERT AND INFORMATION NETWORK (RAIN) EARLY FLOOD WARNING SYSTEM; DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SUCH AGREEMENT TOGETHER WITH ANY SUPPLEMENTAL DOCUMENTS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution to adopt an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) between the City of Fort Lauderdale (City) and Broward County (County); and

WHEREAS, RAIN is a County-wide proactive early flood warning system comprised of multiple urban flood units designed to enhance public safety during severe weather events; and

WHEREAS, once installed, staff will be able to monitor real-time hydrologic conditions and make better informed, data-driven decisions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated in this resolution.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby Interlocal Agreement (ILA) between the City of Fort Lauderdale (City) and Broward County (County), in substantially the form attached as Exhibit 1 – Interlocal Agreement to Commission Agenda Memorandum 26-0723 and delegates authority to the City Manager to execute such agreement together with any and all ancillary or subsequent documents necessary and incidental to the administration of the agreement.

SECTION 3. That the Office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
