Re: Authority of Chief Executive Officer to Bind Marathon Health, LLC

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter confirms the authority of Chris Pricco, as Chief Executive Officer of Marathon Health, LLC, a limited liability company formed under the laws of the State of Delaware ("Marathon"), to execute and deliver binding agreements on behalf of the Marathon.

Marathon is organized under the Delaware Limited Liability Company Act, which governs the internal affairs and authority structure of Marathon. In its limited liability company agreement, pursuant to 6 Del. C. s. 18-407, Marathon has authorized the appointment of officers, including its chief executive officer, and delegated to such officers, rights and powers to manage the business and affairs of the company, including the right to enter into agreements and bind the company.

For purpose of transaction occurring in Florida, the authority of a person to bind a limited liability company is recognized under FL Stat s. 605.0301(4), where, as here, such authority is granted under the law of another state.

Based on the foregoing, as Marathon is a duly formed Delaware limited liability company in good standing that has been duly appointed and delegated the authority to enter into agreements to conduct company affairs in accordance with the Marathon's limited liability company agreement to its chief executive officer, any agreement executed by Chris Pricco as Chief Executive Officer on behalf of Marathon in connection with Marathon's business constitutes a valid and binding obligation of Marathon, enforceable in accordance with its terms, subject to applicable law.

This letter may be relied upon by third parties as evidence of the authority of Marathon's Chief Executive Officer, Chris Pricco, to bind Marathon.
