TITLE: Resolution Approving a Public Transportation Grant Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation for the Construction of the Runway 27 Bypass Taxiway and Run-Up Area Relocation Project at Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport and to Delegate Authority to the City Manager to Execute the Agreement - \$113,362 - **(Commission District 1)**

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution approving the Public Transportation Grant Agreement (PTGA) to accept grant funding up to \$113,362 from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for the Runway 27 Bypass Taxiway and Run-Up Area Relocation Project at Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport (FXE) and authorize the City Manager to execute the agreement.

Background

FXE continues to enhance the safety, efficiency, and operational capacity of the airfield in accordance with its approved Airport Layout Plan (ALP), last updated and approved by the Federal Aviation Administration in 2019. A priority improvement identified in the plan is the Runway 27 Bypass Taxiway and Run-Up Area Relocation Project.

The project is designed to address aircraft congestion and ground movement delays at the east end of Runway 27. Aircraft staging for departure experience delays due to limited taxiway access and insufficient run-up space. The run-up area is a designated area where aircraft perform safety and engine checks before takeoff.

The proposed improvements include constructing two (2) new bypass taxiways and realigning existing bypass taxiways between Runway 27 and Taxiway Alpha, one of the primary taxiways. As a bid alternate, the project also expands and relocates the aircraft run-up area to provide additional space for multiple aircraft to safely stage and prepare for departure.

The Aviation Advisory Board is slated to consider acceptance of this PTGA at its meeting on February 26, 2026.

Resource Impact

This action will result in a positive impact to the City in the amount of \$113,362 with a City match of \$113,362. The balance needed in the amount of \$6,670 will be added to the available project balance of \$106,692 for the City grant match, which will be appropriated to the accounts below contingent upon the approval of the Consolidated Budget Amendment (CAM #26-0061) on the March 3, 2026 City Commission Regular Meeting agenda.
